
Notice of Public Information Centre #1

Township of Hamilton, Water Supply Master Plan

The Township of Hamilton initiated a Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Master Plan to identify existing conditions, residual capacity in the current system, and future upgrades to the water supply, treatment, storage and distribution infrastructure to accommodate future growth in the Township of Hamilton. This Master Plan is being completed in accordance with the Municipal Engineers Association (MEA) Class EA Approach 1 master planning process.

The Water Supply Master Plan reviews existing population and future growth within the Township of Hamilton's three drinking water serviced areas (including Baltimore/Creighton Heights, Camborne and Buttersfield) for the next 20 years, and identify opportunities to improve the overall performance and reliability of the water systems. The Master Plan study will be assessing various options to improve the performance and reliability of the water infrastructure.

Public and agency consultation is a key part of the Master Planning process. The Public Information Centre provides an opportunity for the public and stakeholder agencies to speak directly to the Project Team.



The Public Information Centre No. 1 will provide an overview of the work completed to-date, including a review of study boundary, existing serviced connections, future development within the Study Area over the Master Plan timeframe, as well as existing servicing constraints findings.
